How to Apply for a Travel Grant

A **travel grant of up to £500** will be available for UK based SMEs¹ to join the NanoMission Russia 2010. Companies who join the mission and present as part of the conference program will qualify for a free delegate pass. Grants will be awarded on a competitive basis to assist with the cost of travel and hotel accommodation. The grant will cover 50% of these costs, with a maximum grant of £500 available to each company.
